



Vocabulary :	Definition :
civil war	War between different sides in the same country.
House of York	Branch of the English royal House of Plantagenet. Three of its members became kings of England : Edward IV, Edward V and Richard III.
House of Lancaster	Branch of the English royal House of Plantagenet. Three of its members became kings of England : Henry VI, Henry V and Henry VII.
Plantagenet	The name of the family which all the kings of England from 1154 to 1485 belonged to.
Wars of the Roses	Civil wars for the control of the throne of England, fought between two rival branches of the Royal House of Plantagenet.
Tudor	English royal 'house' of Welsh origin.

The Wars of the Roses

At the beginning of the 15th century, England was ruled by the House of Lancaster. Henry IV held the throne of England but not everybody was happy about this. A grandson of Edward III, Henry IV had rivals for the throne from his own family.

Henry IV's father was John of Gaunt - Duke of Lancaster and John's brother was Edmund - the Duke of York. The two families of Lancaster and York both wanted to rule England and this family feud was to lead to the Wars of the Roses.

The war was given its name due to the symbols of each house : a red rose for Lancaster and a white rose for York.

22 nd May 1455	Wars of the Roses begins
4 th November 1470	Edward V born
21 st May 1471	Henry VI dies
9 th April 1483	Edward IV dies
April to 26 th June 1483	Edward V rules
2 nd June 1483 - 22 nd August 1485	Richard III rules
22 nd August 1485	Battle of Bosworth Richard III is killed
30 th October 1485	Henry VII is crowned and begins the Tudor monarchy
