

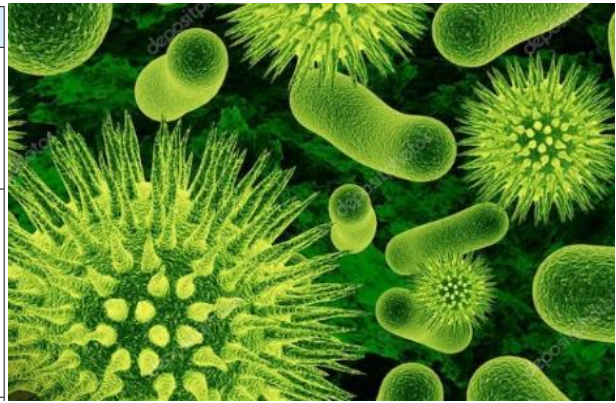


# Science - Famous Scientists

Ole Kirk Christiansen invented Lego in 1949	Louis Pasteur discovered that <b>germs</b> are living things that can be spread by touch or through the air. Marie Curie was a famous scientist who developed the use of <b>x-rays</b> , which meant that a lot more patients could be correctly diagnosed and treated.
	Linda Brown Buck is an American biologist. She discovered that mammals have odorant receptors in their noses. This means they can smell over 10,000 different smells. She won the Nobel Prize in 2004.		

## X-rays

Bones are used for supporting our bodies, protecting our organs and allowing our limbs to move. X-rays are electromagnetic radiations that can pass through opaque materials and enable us to see images of things inside our bodies, such as bones, teeth and joints.
