

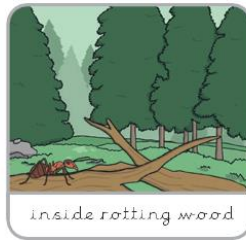
Food chains and Habitats

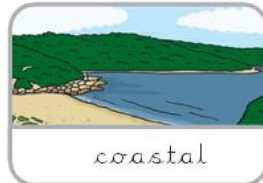
A **habitat** is the natural place something lives. A **habitat** provides **living** things with everything they need to **survive** such as food, shelter and water.

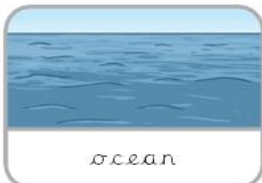

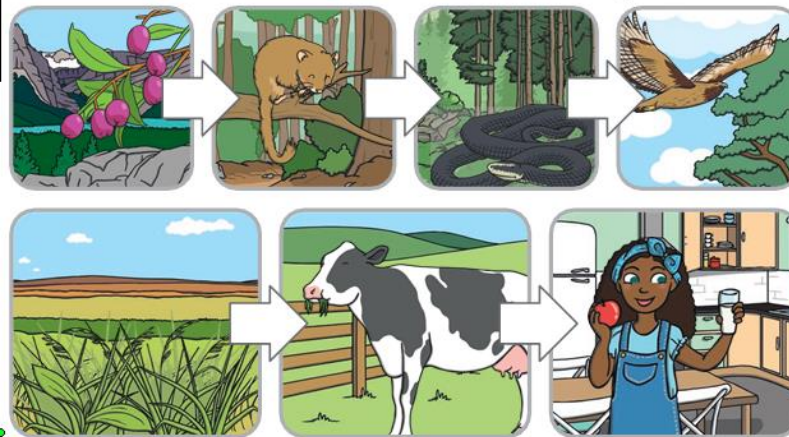
